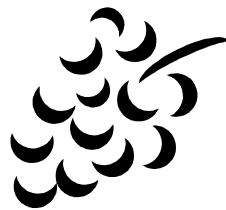

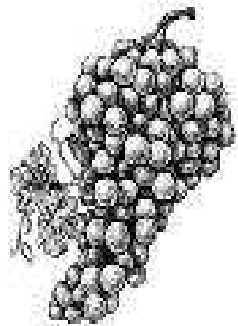

Northwest Italy

Piedmont (Piemonte), Lombardy (Lombardia), Liguria, Valle d'Aosta

*Unquestionably, one of the finest red wine regions in the world.
Piedmont is home to Nebbiolo, the grape of Barolo.
Sometimes harsh when young, they age into rich, majestic, full-bodied wines.
The best vintages live 20- plus years before peaking.
Tar and dark red roses are often used to describe the nose.*

Piedmont is also home to Barbera, Gattinara, Dolcetto, and Brachetto d'Aqui.

Tuscany (Toscana), Latium (Lazio)

*The region of **Tuscany** is dominated by Sangiovese, the grape used to make Chianti.
Chianti is ruby to garnet colored, medium-bodied and a mouthful of juicy cherry and plum fruits.
Classico indicates two years of age and Riserva indicates three or more years.*

BRUNELLO DI MONTALCINO

These wines age beautifully and some taste great after 20 years in the bottle.
